Logistics technology company Intelcom announced today the beginning of its operations at a new high-volume sorting hub that can sort and send out over 500,000 packages per day for last-mile delivery. The new hub is strategically located in Mississauga, in Ontario, close to several large retailers with distributions centers and Pearson International Airport. This new technology will allow a wider range of merchants to work with Intelcom, by offering them a single point of entry for their parcels.

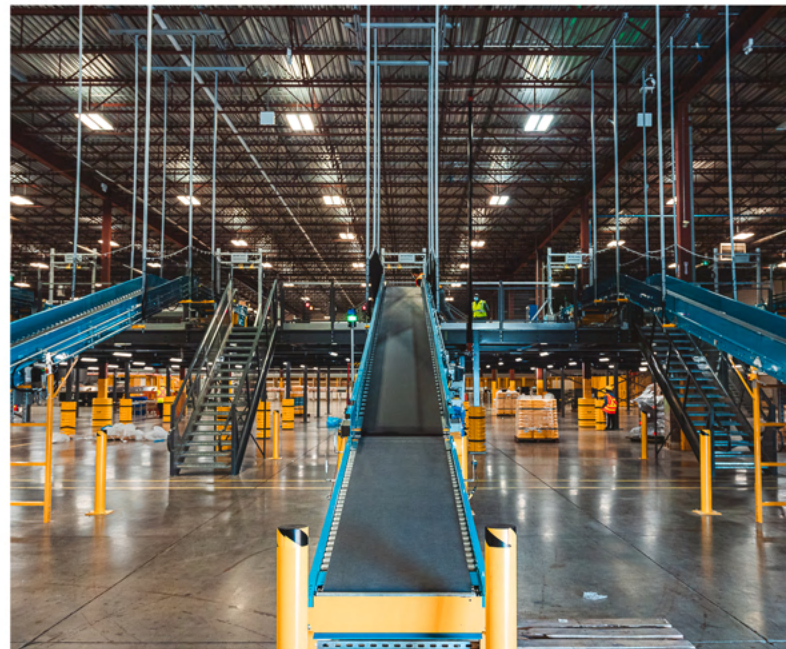
FACTS ABOUT THE NEW MISSISSAUGA HUB

Investment of \$12M for the new facility in Ontario –an additional 9M\$ is already committed to create the upcoming Montreal hub in 2022

Strategically located in Eastern Canada's epicenter of logistics and transportation, Mississauga

Equipped with two automated conveyors that can sort 12,000 and 9,000 packages per hour, respectively

Operates 24 hours a day and has the capacity of sorting over 500,000 packages daily



INTELCOM NOW AND TOMORROW

Will deploy similar technology to standardize its provincial sorting hubs, first in Montréal in early 2022 and then in British Columbia, Alberta and the Maritimes.

Plans to deliver over 42 million packages across Canada for the last quarter of 2021

Employs more than 1,800 permanent people and contracts daily with over 470 independent delivery contractors.

Currently operates over 65 sorting stations in Canada

Delivers to all ten Canadian provinces, in addition to the Northwest Territories and Yukon.
